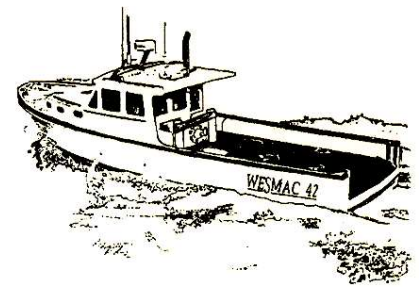

Four Belles is a stunning and versatile down east style boat that has fished the length of the Eastern Seaboard as well as the Caribbean and the Bahamas. She's a head-turner everywhere she goes. Wesmac signature hard chine and soft entry provide a truly comfortable ride when the going gets rough. You'll be the first boat off the dock in a gale and the last to leave the fishing grounds due to weather. Four Belles stands out in a crowd – Truly beautiful and 100% custom.

Four Belles Construction and History:

Built by Wesmac in 2004, Four Belles was refit at the Wesmac shop in 2014 with a clean and elegant interior, all new systems including generator, electronics, refrigeration, fish hold and much more. Transmission was rebuilt in 2018. In 2019 she received a new transmission cooler, new cutlass, and new intermediate cutlass.

Interior:

Four Belles interior is equipped with a pilot station, co-pilot station, galley/salon, head, and berths. The Hereshoff-styling with cherry trim and cabinetry offset the white gel coat paneling, giving her interior clean lines, with an open and feel.

Key features:

- Well thought out lighting
- Opening windows and ports for above average ventilation
- Abundant storage
- Bright contrasting wood sole
- Pilot Salon/Galley

Pilot Salon

- Large wrap around seating with insert, can be used for additional sleeping

- 4 Storage compartments under seating
- Custom removable carpet and padding
- Overhead rod holders that can accommodate up to 6 offshore fishing rods

Co-Pilot Station

Continuing forward of the Pilot Salon/Galley on the port side is the Co-Pilot Station with a double raised bench seat with adjustable arm rests that offers exceptional visibility and comfort. This area also features:

- Overhead dome light
- Opening window outboard
- Windshield wiper for forward facing window
- Drawer storage below seat
- 12-Volt outlet

Pilot Station

The large Pilot Station sits to the starboard of the co-pilot station with a 360-degree view, well laid out controls and access to mechanical and electrical systems. The Pilot Station also features:

- Full suite of electronics (see Electronics)
- Overhead dome lighting
- Windshield wipers for starboard and center forward facing windows
- Opening window outboard
- Engine, bow and stern thruster controls (see Mechanical Systems)
- Search light control head
- Windshield wiper controls
- Remote anchor windlass controls
- Bilge pump control panel
- Stidd adjustable helm seat
- Electrical panel inboard (see Electrical System)
- 12-Volt outlet / USB port
- Exterior Starboard Door

Control Room

As you head down the companionway steps from the pilot salon, immediately to starboard is the control room.

- Satellite Phone Base
- Directv Controls
- 110/24V inverter to rigid deck lights
- USCG required placards on interior Control Room door

Head

As you pass the control room on the portside, you will find Four Belles head and walk in stall shower.

Large and open this area features:

Head

- Overhead dome lighting
- Opening port light
- Vanity mirror
- Locker storage above and below counter
- Corian counters
- Dual control pressurized hot and cold fresh water mixer head
- Single basin sink
- Built in towel hooks on head door
- AquaT electric marine head

Shower Stall

- Opening port light
- Single lever pressurized hot and cold fresh water shower wand with hose

Forward Cabin

Continuing forward, through the lower companionway, you enter the forward cabin with her v-berth bunk. The inside of the hull is treated with cherry slats and white paneling giving the cabin a luxurious feel with great light. This area is also highlighted by:

- Aft opening deck hatch
- Overhead dome lighting
- Adjustable LED reading lights (2)
- Locker storage port, starboard, and forward outboard of bunk
- 24" LED TV

Bunks

As you leave the forward cabin, heading aft, to port is the 2 bunks that feature great usage of space while not sacrificing storage. The bunks feature:

- Dome lighting overhead
- Adjustable LED reading lights (2)
- Opening port light (2)
- Storage compartments below bunk

Utility Closet

Returning to the pilot salon on Four Belles port is a utility closet that also offers a custom rod and reel rack.
